Non-BBQ Food & Beverage Vendor Policies 2012 Iowa State BBQ Championships

Booth

- Vendor is responsible for own physical booth – tent, trailer, shelter etc.
- All signage must be affixed to the booth.
- Guy wires must be visibly identified to avoid accidents.
- Please be prepared for all weather conditions. The Festival will be held rain, wind, or shine.
- Vendor will set up on Friday morning, June 22, 2012, at Riverview Park, 402 Woodland Street, Marshalltown, Iowa, prior to 10:00 a.m.
- Vendor must be prepared to sell during the entire operating hours of the Championships - Friday 4 p.m. – 11 p.m. and Saturday 11 a.m. – 4 p.m.
- The Festival committee shall determine the location of the Vendor's booth.
- Vendor will keep the booth and surrounding areas clean at all times.
- All menu items and their prices must be clearly posted.
- Vendors must provide their own garbage cans and bags.
- Seating for patrons will be provided in a central location.

Fees

- Registration fees of \$150 for commercial vendors and \$75 for non-profit groups are payable in advance with this application.
- Vendors will be notified in writing of their acceptance. In the event that a Vendor is not accepted, the registration fee will be refunded.
- Vendors are responsible for collecting and paying all related sales tax. Vendor certifies that it is registered with the Iowa Department of Revenue to collect sales tax.
- Vendors shall take tickets during the event to be turned in periodically. Competition organizers will pay vendors 80% of gross ticket sales following the event.

Insurance

- Vendor will provide a copy of applicable liability insurance. Vendor agrees to indemnify and hold the Festival Committee, Iowa BBQ Society, and all sponsoring agencies harmless from all claims, damages, costs, and liabilities that arise from or in connection with Vendor's acts or omissions under this agreement.
- The Festival Committee is not responsible for the loss or damage of Vendor's property, equipment, or supplies, whether attributable to theft, vandalism, spoilage, weather, or any other cause.

Electricity and Water

- Vendor will work with the Festival Committee to meet electrical and water requirements. Vendor may need to provide own generator, as access to electricity is limited at the Festival site.
- Water spigots will be available from River View Park.

Health, Sanitation and Fire

- Vendor will comply with all health, sanitation, and fire regulations required under local, state, or federal law.
- Vendor will obtain all necessary vending and food permits.
- No dogs are allowed at this event by ordinance of the City of Marshalltown.

Publicity

- The Festival Committee has the right to identify Vendor as a participating vendor and use Vendor's business name and trademark in advertising and promoting the Festival.
- The Festival Committee does not guarantee sales, anticipated crowds, or other expectations.

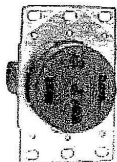
